National Honor Society Induction Postponed due to School Closures

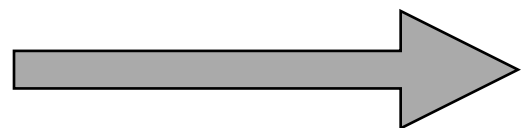
