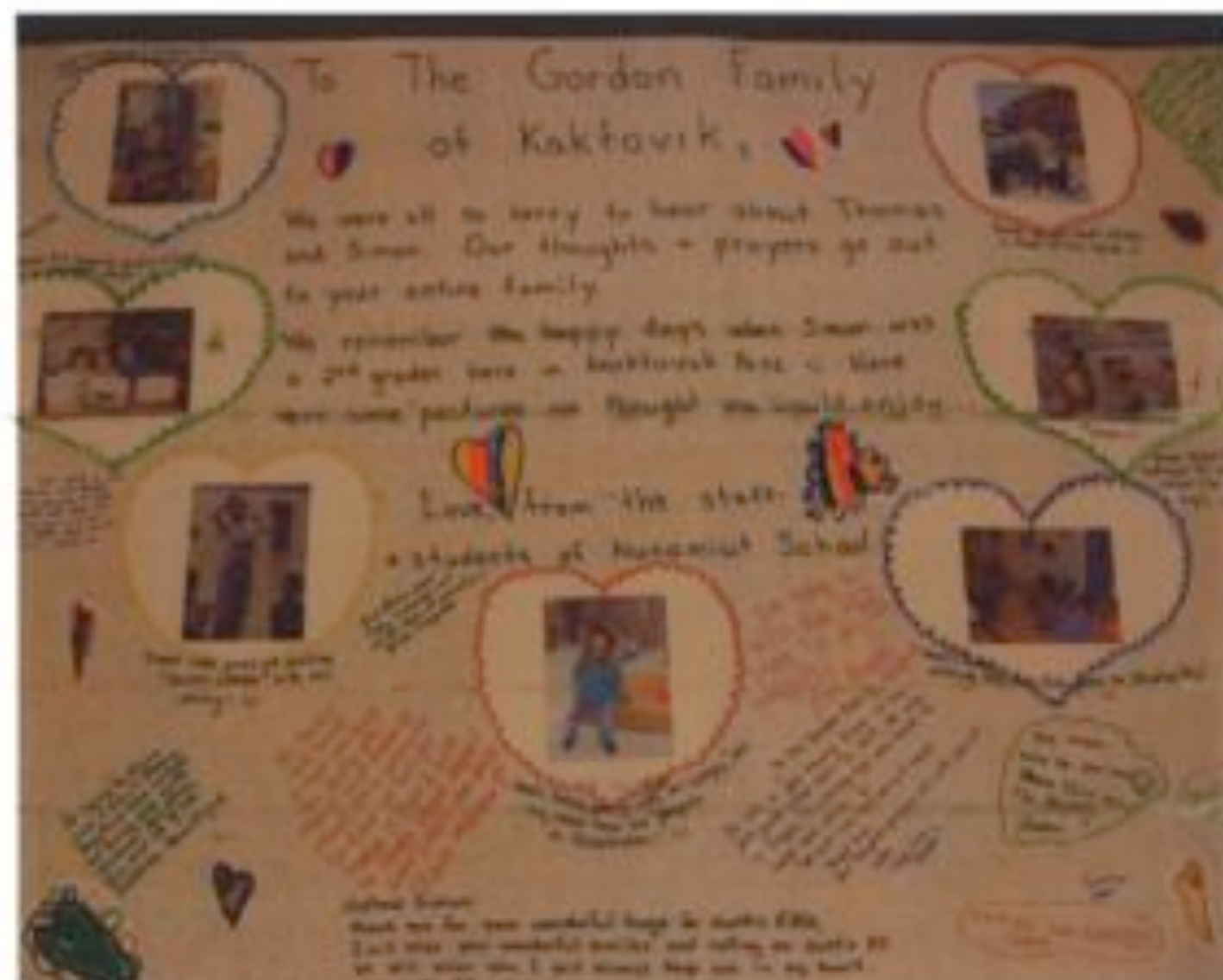

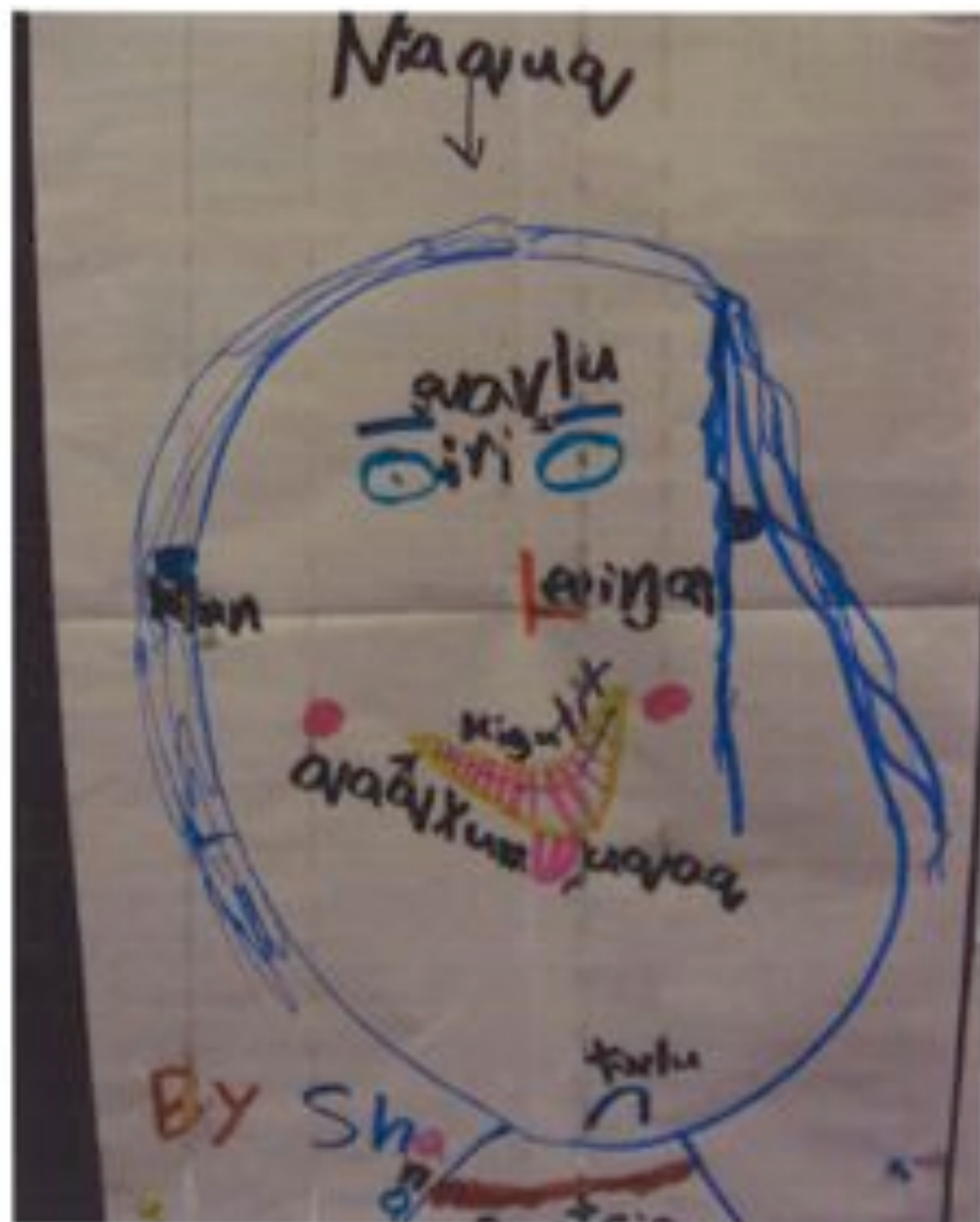

Students wrote their memories of 'Toda (Grandpa) Justus' and drew pictures of him as an angel in Heaven...



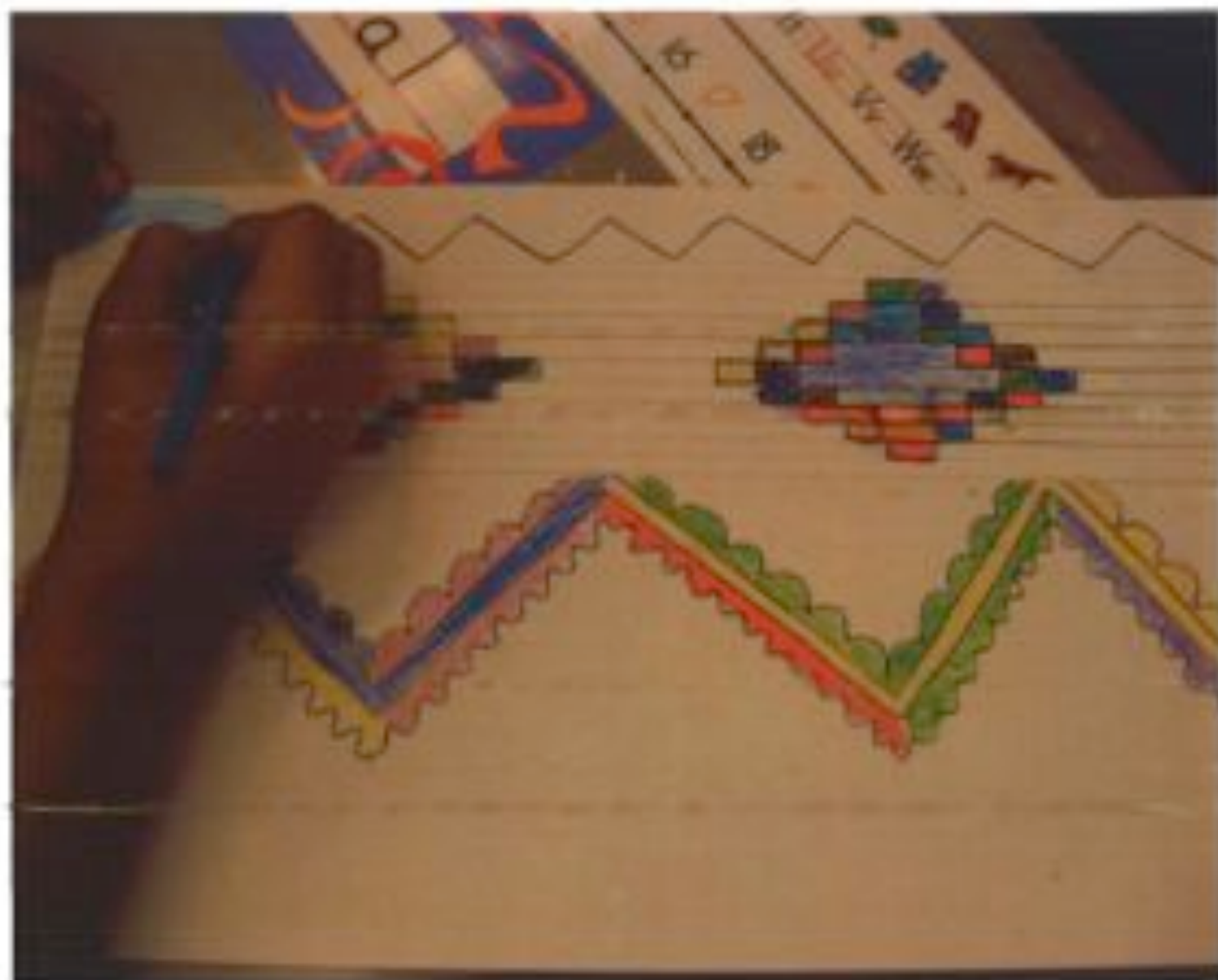
