This is what you should see when the game you select opens.



The game will automatically load to the highest level of play available based on previous plays. You will see other user's scores in the boxes for levels of play. It is a good idea to go to the pre-play level which is VIVA I. You can do that by clicking on the VIVA I icon.

This level will allow you to listen to each of the clips before you go to play the easiest level which is the orange level. After listening to all of the clips you can reload the game and if you click on the orange level it should only present you with 4 pictures at a time. Once you have mastered the orange level click on the red level and continue going through the levels till you have mastered all of them.
